 - Convention was held in Vancouver, Canada
 - Celebrated the 90th anniversary of AA
 - 79 Countries were represented at the convention
 - 34,000 members attended
 - 4,000 volunteers from Canada
 - The longest sobriety member was a man with 65 years.
 - There were 10 sessions during the day to choose from
 - 200 members had 50 years of sobriety – 12 names were pulled from a hat and these members were able to speak at the convention for 5 minutes each
 - The next convention will be held in 5 years in St. Louis
