

- The chapter, “To Wives,” is now titled, “To Partners.”
- In the Into Action chapter, a discussion paragraph is added after each step, (worded much like a sponsor would explain the step to a new sponsee).
- The “Jaywalker” is now a woman.
- Traditions and Concepts will be in an index in the back of the Big Book, with definitions.
- A consistent use of the word “donation” will be used to note monies from outside the membership, which is still never permitted. The term, “contribution” is used to note monies coming from the membership.
- La Viña, the Spanish language version of The Grapevine, will be required to submit a plan to show how it will be self-supporting by the 75th General Conference. If no such plan is shown, future support for the publication will be withdrawn.
- The 2025 General Service Conference title is, “Working Together, Increasing Trust.”
- The committee recommended 5 options for closing the meetings at the International Convention, including the Serenity Prayer, Third Step Prayer, a Moment of Silence, the Seventh Step Prayer, the Responsibility Statement and the Declaration of Unity. The Lord’s Prayer was not included, as AA is not a Christian organization.
- Registration for the 2025 International Conference in Vancouver, British Columbia, Canada, opens on September 10, 2024. Hotel information is provided after registration for the conference.
